The summer's premiere road event, celebrating its return benefiting Big Brothers-Big Sisters of West Central Texas. Starting out from the Old Settlers' Reunion Grounds at Buffalo Gap (15 miles

## Weekly Rides

Mondays in DST. A good ride for new riders and getting to know others. Leaders will stop and let everyone catch up. Regular route to the east to Potosi area. Coordinated by Biketown

Shake off the week's troubles and start the weekend early with this speedy ride from Biketown parking lot during DST months. Bring a light early or late in the season. Coordinated by Biketown.
